The PTA fund-raises and supports the school through various activities and events.

In April this year our Bring & Buy raised **£165** and the cake stalls held at the “Landulph Memorial Hall Big Breakfast” events raised **£174** altogether.



Another way of helping us to raise more funds is the recycling of ink cartridges and old mobile phones. **£30.50** has been gained from this scheme, so please continue to send in these items. There is a collection box in the shared area of the school where the children/parents/carers/staff can place their old items and we can post them on for you. The collection of old clothes, soft toys, shoes etc.. by “Bag 2 School” raised **£64** and another collection has been planned for January 2010. So start collecting and hopefully we can beat this amount next time!!

£25.06 commission has been received via the Yellow Moon catalogue. So have a look at it next time your children bring one home. It has many ideas in it for birthdays, Christmas and craft activities and a percentage of the amount you spend goes towards our school.

We are very excited to report that we have been successful in gaining a grant from “Sport England” and “His Royal Highness Prince of Wales Duchy of Cornwall” towards the purchase of a new sports shed and equipment. Hopefully weather permitting the shed will be installed during October half term.

Plans are also in hand to create an Adventure Trim Trail on the school grounds. At present we have received **£1000** form The Hedley Foundation and set aside some money from our fund raising. Our Grants Representative continues to apply for further funding towards this project.

Also we will be selling 2009 Landulph School tea towels at the school production in December – so watch out for that masterpiece – a fantastic gift for the relatives!

Finally we would like to thank all those who support our PTA events either by donating, giving their time or buying items. Remember all the above money raised goes to the benefit of the children at our fantastic school.
